# MINUTES SUMMIT HOUSING AUTHORITY January 23, 2013

Chairperson Dennis White called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Janet Whitman Room. The following Commissioners answered as present:

Commissioner Richard Poole, Commissioner Jeffrey Halverstadt (7:05), Commissioner Pam Kuhn, Commissioner Dennis White, Commissioner Coalter Pollock, and Commissioner Steven Spurr.

Also present were Louis A. Riccio, Executive Director and Melissa Kuzma, Deputy Executive Director.

Mr. Riccio read the Open Public Meetings Act Notice, "Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided by the Secretary of the Housing Authority of the City of Summit by preparing an amended Annual Notice dated <u>December 12, 2012</u>, setting forth the date, time and place of this meeting. Said notice was filed with the Clerk of the City of Summit, forwarded to newspapers of local circulation and to the persons requesting it.

## APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 12, 2012 REGULAR BOARD MEETING:

Commissioners Poole and Spurr moved and seconded approval of the Minutes. The roll call was unanimous and the minutes were approved.

#### CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT: None.

REPORT OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR: Mr. Riccio reported that the roof is 95% complete. He also reported that we are experiencing severe issues with the heat pumps at the senior building, and that any seniors whose apartment temperatures are below 68 degrees will be given portable heaters until the issues are resolved. Our maintenance workers are spending almost 100% of their time working on heat issues. Our HVAC contractor will be looking at the heat pumps tomorrow morning to see if he can determine what is causing the problem.

<u>REPORT OF DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:</u> Ms. Kuzma reported that her last day at the Housing Authority will be March 29, 2013. She also reported that she received over 200 resumes for the Office Administrator position and will meet with the personnel committee before commencing with interviews.

**Operations:** Vice Chairperson Kuhn noted that the electric bill was high again. Mr. Riccio said that the next step would be to bring in an engineer to see what is going on. Ms. Kuhn also questioned why the benefits line for 2012 was so much lower than budget.

**Affordable Housing:** Commissioner Poole reported on potential projects with the Unitarian Church and Christ Church. The McFarland project was also reviewed and there was a discussion of the transit village.

**Buildings & Grounds:** Commissioner Pollack noted that a window was still broken at Weaver Street and that the gutter was still broken at Glenwood Place building 3.
